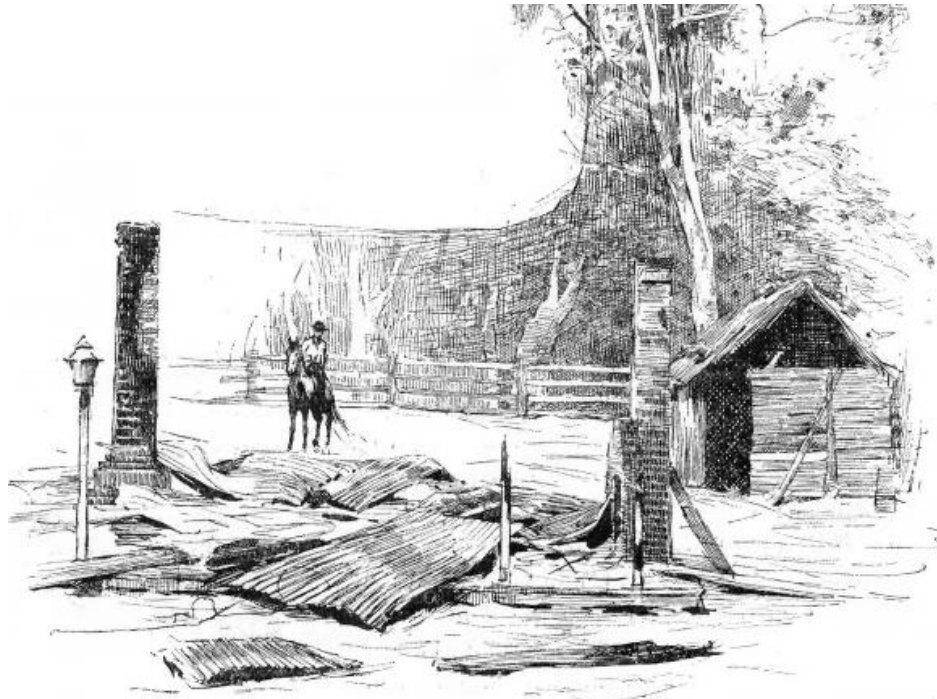

He had just walked into the **bar** and was drinking a glass of whisky when a ball struck him in the groin. I heard him fall, and saw the blood spurting from him. I think he died very soon. This seemed to dishearten Dan Kelly and Hart. They had been calling for Ned all night, and they renewed their calls for him. We had not seen the leader of the gang since the fighting commenced, and did not know where he had gone to. Dan and Hart went in to the inside room, and I heard one say to the other, 'What will we do!' I did not hear the reply; but Reardon said he thought they intended to commit suicide.

We prayed for daylight thinking that we might then escape, but even when the morning broke, we dared not venture out. It must have been at this time that poor Martin Sherry was shot.
